VEHICLE VS. LAWNMOWER

Granite Falls

Approximately noon today the Snohomish County Sheriff's Office Collision Investigation Unit (CIU) was called to the scene of a vehicle vs. riding lawn mower collision on 75th ST NE. Initial reports were that a small vehicle driven by a male driver struck a riding lawnmower that had been driven into the roadway. The male operator of the mower was airlifted to the hospital.

At 5 p.m. today investigators were advised the operator of the lawnmower passed away at Harborview Hospital.

There is no additional information available at this time about the driver or lawnmower operator. There are no indications of speed, drugs or alcohol involvement. There are no charges or arrest at this time. CIU is continuing their investigation before any determinations can be made. There are no anticipated updates on this incident Tuesday.
