CAR vs. PEDESTRIANS

South Snohomish County

Approximately 11 p.m. Thursday night Snohomish County Deputies were dispatched to a citizen's report of a collision that was heard but not seen. While deputies and aid personnel were responding additional calls were received. Reporting parties advised that a vehicle had struck two pedestrians. Upon arrival deputies learned that an SUV driven by a teen age male had struck two of four pedestrians that were walking in the road in the 5800 block of 148th St SW. Initial reports indicate that a group of four Everett teens (two girls and two boys) were walking westbound on 148th when the vehicle approached from behind and struck the two boys.

One of the boys sustained leg injuries while the other sustained leg and possible head injuries; both were treated and transported to Harborview by FPD 1 medical personnel.

The Snohomish County Sheriff's Office Traffic Enforcement Unit is conducting the investigation. At this time there is no indication that there is any impairment on the part of the driver. The investigation is looking at speed, sight distance, and pedestrian visibility as proximate cause of this incident.

The investigation is ongoing.
