236TH ST SHOOTING

Edmonds

At 8:01 this evening Snohomish County Sheriff's Office deputies and officers from the Edmonds Police department responded to the 8800 block of 236th St SW for a man down in the street. Upon arrival officers discovered a male that had been shot 3 times. The victim was given first aid until fire department medics arrived who stabilized him and transported to Harborview hospital.

At this time there is no motive or explanation for this event. Officers and deputies are canvassing the neighborhood looking for witnesses that may be able to help put this all together. The Sheriff's Office Major Crimes Unit (MCU) is continuing the investigation. There are no suspects and no arrests have been made.
