Edmonds area shooting - update

A 23-year-old Edmonds area man who was shot last night in his home is reportedly doing better today and is expected to survive his injuries. No arrests have been made in the shooting.

The man was in his home in the 23500 block of 88th Place W. when he was shot three times. Detectives believe the suspect was outside and fired into the house. While detectives do not have any suspects or a motive at this point, they do not believe this was a random act of violence, and they do not believe the surrounding community is in danger.

After the shooting, the victim and a friend got into a car and started driving down the street. The victim, who was bleeding profusely, got out of the vehicle and his friend called 911. Deputies found the man lying in the 8800 block of 236th St. SW. He was taken to Harborview Medical Center in Seattle.
