Search and Rescue Recovery

Search and rescue workers recovered the body of a 39-year-old Duvall woman last night who fell earlier in the day while climbing in the Monte Cristo area.

The woman and her hiking companion – a 39-year-old Duvall man – were climbing in a snow field when the woman lost her footing and fell about 700 feet over a cliff.

The man climbed down to where she fell and discovered her body. He made it back down to the Monte Cristo town site for help late Sunday afternoon.

The Sheriff's Office helicopter was used to hoist rescue workers down to her body so they could bring her out in the helicopter.
