Marysville shooting

A 63-year-old Marysville woman was in critical condition Wednesday afternoon after she was shot earlier in the day by her boyfriend *or ex-boyfriend* in the home they shared.

The shooting was reported at 12:18 p.m. The woman lived in the home in the 4400 block of 128th Pl. NE with her three teenage daughters and her 70-year-old boyfriend.

The 70-year-old man was in the process of moving out of the house. For some reason, he walked into the living room and shot the woman in front of her three daughters and two friends who were visiting the woman.

The victim was airlifted to Harborview Medical Center in Seattle. She was in the operating room as of Wednesday afternoon.

The suspect fled the house in a dark, mid 1990s Bronco. He was later spotted and arrested by a Snohomish County Sheriff's deputy on Highway 530 near Oso. He has not yet been booked into the Snohomish County Jail.

Detectives were getting search warrants Wednesday afternoon for the house and the Bronco. No weapon has been recovered yet. Detectives say the suspect shot the victim with a handgun. They also were talking to witnesses to determine a motive.

Detectives did not say how many times the victim was shot nor where on her body she was shot.
