Fatal shooting in Lake Stevens area cul-de-sac

One woman and one man were dead following a shooting in a neighborhood in the 300 block of 119th Drive SE in unincorporated Lake Stevens.

Shortly after 1:30 p.m. today someone in the neighborhood called to report a disturbance outside between a man and woman, involving a gun.

As the first of several deputies arrived on scene, she heard several gunshots and witnessed a man fall to the ground. As she got closer, she discovered two bodies on the ground outside. Aid arrived and pronounced both the man and woman dead at the scene.

Detectives believe the man was the shooter and that this was not a random act. A handgun was recovered at the scene. Based on the information gathered so far, the 31-year-old man and 27-year-old woman were ex-boyfriend/ex-girlfriend.

The woman was staying with someone who lived in the cul de sac, near where the shooting happened. The man did not live in the neighborhood.

The Snohomish County Medical Examiner's Office will determine and release the identities of the man and woman as well as their ages.

There is no additional information to release at this time.
