Man in critical after being shot in groin at Snohomish-area house

Snohomish County Sheriff's detectives are investigating an early morning shooting that happened in the 17700 block of Broadway Ave. in unincorporated Snohomish.

Someone at the house called 911 about 1:30 a.m. to report a shooting at the residence. Detectives learned that the victim – a 30-year-old man who was visiting the house – was outside when he was confronted by four or five men. The victim apparently knows the men and was afraid of them so he ran back in the house. The suspects followed him and one of them shot the victim in the groin. The suspects fled.

The victim was taken to Harborview Medical Center in Seattle where he is reportedly in critical condition.

No arrests have been made yet. Detectives continue to investigate the shooting, including the motive and the relationship between the victim and the suspects.
