Lynnwood man at Harborview with stab wounds

Detectives are investigating a stabbing that took place early this morning at an apartment in the 3600 block of 156th St. SW in unincorporated Lynnwood.

The incident was actually discovered shortly after 1:30 a.m. when a Washington State Patrol trooper contacted the driver of a car parked along southbound I-5 near I-405. The car was blocking traffic. The trooper noticed that the female driver appeared to have been drinking. She told the trooper she had been raped and that she had stabbed her alleged attacker and that he was at his apartment.

When police went to the man's apartment, they found him semi-conscious with multiple stab wounds. He was taken to Harborview Medical Center in Seattle. We do not have any information on his condition at this time.

The 26-year-old female suspect and 55-year-old male victim know each other, but the context of their relationship is unclear. The woman was taken to a local hospital for evaluation and is expected to be booked into the Snohomish County Jail today for investigation of first-degree assault. The investigation continues.
