Detectives investigate shooting outside Martha Lake party

One man was shot in the knee late Thursday night shortly after he and his friends were turned away at the door of a party at the Martha Lake Community Club. The call came in at about 11:45 p.m.

The 23-year-old Edmonds area man was with two other men at the time of the shooting. After being turned away at the door of the club in the 17600 block of Motor Place in unincorporated Lynnwood, the men started talking to a young woman in the parking lot. Two vehicles pulled into the parking lot and words were exchanged between the people in the vehicles and the three men concerning the woman.

Both vehicles left the parking lot but were just a short distance away when someone in one of the vehicles fired shots back at the three men who were on foot. It's unclear if the shooter got out and fired shots or fired shots from the vehicle. The 23-year-old man was the only one injured. He was taken to a local hospital for treatment. His injury is not life-threatening.

Detectives spoke to several people in a couple of different possible suspect vehicles, but no arrests have been made so far.

We do not have suspect information or vehicle information to release at this time. The case remains under investigation.
