**Snohomish County Sheriff's Office Investigates Fatal Collision**

On July 10<sup>th</sup>, 2010 deputies responded to a report of a vehicle collision in the 17800 block of Engebretsen Road near Granite Falls. When deputies arrived they conducted a preliminary investigation and discovered that two passenger cars had apparently been racing eastbound on Engebretsen Road when one of the drivers had lost control of their vehicle and left the roadway to the south. When the vehicle left the roadway it struck a power pole. The driver of the vehicle a 26 year old male from Granite Falls died at the scene as a result of this collision. It appears that speed was a factor. The other vehicle was not directly involved in the collision and remained at the scene until investigators arrived. The Sheriff's Office Collision Investigation Unit was called to the scene and is investigating.
