Car-pedestrian accident in Bothell area

A 74-year-old woman was in critical condition this evening after being hit by a car while crossing the street to get her mail.

The accident happened about 4:45 p.m. near 184th St. SW and North Road in unincorporated Bothell. Collision investigators said the woman stepped in front of the compact car as she crossed North Road and was struck. She was taken to Harborview Medical Center in Seattle with critical injuries.

Investigators said the crash appears to be a terrible accident; there is no indication that speed, alcohol or aggressive driving played a part in the crash. The driver, a woman in her 40s, also lives in the general area. No citations have been issued; the crash remains under investigation.

A section of North Road is closed at this time, but drivers are able to detour through nearby Lynnwood High School.

Update: The 74-year-old woman critically injured in Thursday night's car-pedestrian crash died overnight at Harborview Medical Center in Seattle.
